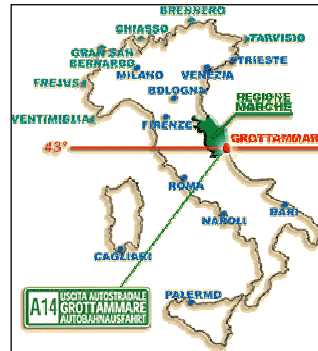
How to reach Grottammare

The closest major train station is San Benedetto del Tronto (2 km), but Grottammare has a station where slow trains stop.

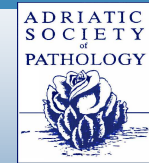
There is an exit from A14 (Adriatica) autostrada.

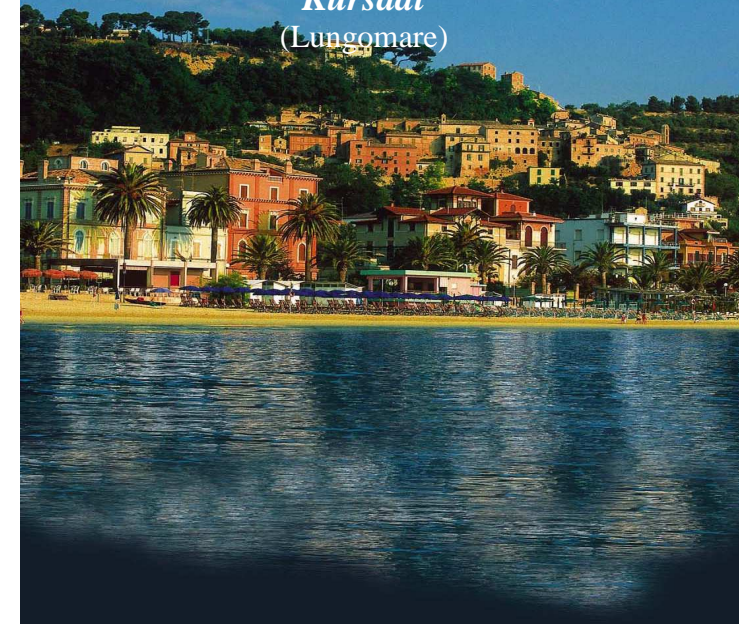
